

BACHELOR OF FINE ARTS (BFA)

Each candidate for the degree is required to complete the following:

- A minimum of 120 credit hours, 84 of which must be graded and 45 of which must be at the 300-400 level.
- A minimum of 99 semester hours of credit in courses that either are offered in the College of Arts and Sciences or would normally be taught by a discipline in a college of arts and sciences.
- A major consisting of no less than 84 hours. BFA with Teacher Licensure includes courses from both Art and Education Departments as major requirements. (See Art Department (<https://catalog.washburn.edu/undergraduate/college-arts-sciences/art/>) for specific requirements for each concentration).
- All general education requirements (<https://catalog.washburn.edu/undergraduate/programs-degrees-graduation-requirements/general-education-requirements/>).
- WU 101 The Washburn Experience.
- An upper-division English composition course (EN 300, EN 308, or EN 312).
- Candidates must have a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.0 and a grade of C or better in each course in the major, required courses, and the English, math, and communication studies general education courses. A double major may be completed within the 120 hour total by meeting all the requirements of the two majors. Students may also elect a minor or certificate.
